



WORLD KNITTING DAY KNITTED SQUARE PATTERN

“ *Knitting, he thought, was a comfort to the soul. It was regular. It was repetitious. And, in the end, it amounted to something.*

Please use 8ply yarn (wool or acrylic) and size 4 needles to make 17cm (6 1/2”) squares.

The finished squares will be arranged and then sewn into warm rugs.

Cast on 2 stitches

Knit 1 then increase into the second stitch. Turn

Next Row: Knit 1 then increase into the second stitch. Knit to end of row.

Continue increasing in this way until you have 48 stitches.

Next Row: Knit to the last 3 stitches, knit 2 tog. then knit 1

Continue knitting whilst decreasing in this way at the end of each row until 2 sts remain – knit 2 tog. and pull through

Stitch loose ends into square.
