CREATION STORY

There are 2 creation stories in the Bible. The first one in Genesis 1 describes the world being created in 6 days, and the second in Genesis 2 has a different way of telling the story. MESSY KITCHEN

In the second creation story, humans are told clearly to 'till' or serve creation, not exploit it. Let's take a look at Fee's vegetable garden and then join her in the Messy Kitchen for some dip and platter ideas.

Do you grow vegetables at home in your yard? Even if you don't have a lot of room, you can still grow some snow peas in a pot and eat them straight from the plant. Or tomatoes also grow in pots. Just remember to water them and put them in sunlight so they grow.

BEETROOT DIP

INGREDIENTS

- 1 x 450g can baby beetroot, drained coarsely chopped
- 250g (1 cup) Tamar Valley Greek style Yoghurt
- 2 tablespoons fresh lemon juice
- 1 teaspoon ground cumin
- 1 teaspoon ground coriander
- Salt and freshly ground pepper, to season

METHOD

Combine ingredients thoroughly in a bowl. Taste and season with salt and pepper. Serve in bowl.

WELCOMING ALL CREATURES

Everything needs somewhere to live. God created the whole world so that it fitted together harmoniously, but people have not looked after it well and so we need to build homes for bugs and other creatures that we need in our gardens.

Flowers also attract bugs and birds. Bees are essential to food production and a healthy climate. They love brightly coloured flowers. Make your own flowers using cupcake liners like the ones here:

Cupcake liner flowers

You need:

- Patty cases aka cupcake cases
- Paper
- Green paper scraps (or colour paper green)
- Glue
- Scissors
- · Pom-poms, sequins, materials or anything crafty

Basically you just create flowers that look anything vaguely like the photo below. Then write the Bible verse underneath to remind us that God made everything beautiful in this world, including us!









CORAL

Creation is amazing. God created the most amazing world to exist harmoniously together. But how much do we know about where we live? For example, what do you know about coral? Coral is a living creature that can be seen from space. Watch this clip and find out lots of incredible facts and find out how we as humans are hurting the coral by the way we live.

Bible story

Using playdough, plasticine, lego or any other toys you have at home, can you retell one of the stories of creation? If you need to be reminded, use the colouring cards or listen again to the Diddy Disciples podcast.

Prayer

Part of the story in Genesis is when the first people are tempted to eat the fruit from the one tree God told them not to touch. We all do things we shouldn't but God always welcomes us back.

Cut up an apple so there are enough pieces for everyone present. If you don't have an apple or you can't eat them, any fruit or vegetable will be fine.

Take a bite and think about something you did this week which you would rather you had not done. You do not need to tell anyone, just take the time to talk to God as you eat your piece of apple. As you are forgiven by God, take the time to forgive someone else.

When you've finished your apple pieces, pray the Lord's Prayer:

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name.

Your kingdom come, your will be done

on earth as in heaven.

Give us today our daily bread.

Forgive us our sins,

as we forgive those who sin against us.

Save us from the time of trial and deliver us from evil.

For the kingdom, the power and the glory are yours now and for ever.
